OFFICIALS: In accordance with the Heads of Agreement, New Zealand is to

nominate two international judges to officiate at these

Championships. Other federations are invited to nominate judges, calculators and referees to officiate at these Championships. The

organizers regret that it is unable to fund such officials.

ENTRY FEES: An \$80.00 per skater per event.

ACCOMMODATION

AND TRAVEL: Travel and accommodation costs are the responsibility of

participating skaters/officials and/or their respective National Federations. Further accommodation information will be available

shortly.

TROPHIES: Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places with all

competitors/officials receiving a souvenir certificate of

participation.

SANCTION: The championship will be conducted with sanctions from F.I.R.S.

and its sub-committees.

AUTHORISED

OFFICIALS: For the supply of a free season pass authorised team officials will

constitute no more than 6 in total including, team manager, assistant team manager, team coach, team doctor (medically qualified person e.g. doctor, physiotherapist). Personal coaches will be required to purchase a season pass to enter the venue.

NOMINATION

FORMS: All entries must be provided by each Federation on the "Entry

Forms" attached. These may also be downloaded from the Skate

Australia website www.skateaustralia.org.au.

ANTI DOPING

CONTROL: Doping Control will be carried out in accordance with F.I.R.S.

Medical Regulations.

COMPETITORS: Each Federation shall use its own method to select the team it

enters for the competition. The team selected by the Australian Federation will be official Australian Team and the team selected by the New Zealand Federation will be the official New Zealand Team.

SPECTATOR FEE: A fee may be charged for any or all sessions (to be confirmed)

VENUE:

Skate Australia, as hirer of the venue, reserves the right to refuse entry to any person. Persons entering the facility agree that it is a condition of entry to the facility that the Association is absolved from all liability and claims however arising from injury or damage as a result of the entrant's attendance at the facility and/or participation. The facility has disability access.

SKATE EXAMINATION:

- All skates may be examined prior to skaters taking the floor for training and competition. Examining of skates involves checking for protruding axels and exposed metal on the toe stop. Protruding axels, exposed toe stop metal and black toe stops are not permitted.
- b) Skates which do not pass the examination process will be required to be altered such that they comply with above.
- c) Skates which cannot be adjusted such that they comply with the regulations will result in the skater not taking the floor for their event.

PRIVACY REQUIREMENTS:

- a) In accordance with Privacy principles skaters should be aware that the competition program and the competition results will be placed on the Skating Federation website's.
- b) Names, skating order and event placings/results will be listed.
- c) Should any person not wish for their details to be listed on this site they should convey this request in writing to the Championship Director not later than 30 minutes after the completion of their event.
- d) Parents will be contacted regarding any photos which are to be used on the web site or for promotional purposes

MUSIC:

- a) All music is to be on DVD
- b) DVD's are to be handed in to the Championship director at the management meeting on the 16th April.
- c) One routine per DVD.
- d) All DVDs must be clearly marked with the skaters name, country, and title of the event.
- e) In the event of DVD music failure, backups or substitute music on another DVD are the coaches/skaters responsibility. NO TAPES
